* Family of the Month (Chairman: Woody Hampshire)

- Select a worthy family every month (doesn't have to be a Knight).
- Submit a 10784 to supreme and <u>Forms@kofcnc.org</u> before the 15th of the month.
- Submission is for the previous month. So April is submitted in May (by the 15th of the month).
- o Great way to get recognition for the Council. Present at Mass.
- Supreme and State awards available.

* Food for Families (Chairman: Mike Spire)

- Help end hunger and support your communities by donating Food to a local food bank.
- For every 1000 pounds of food or \$500 donated, Supreme will give the Council \$100. Fill out the 10057.

* Keep Christ in Christmas (Chairman: Paul Spire)

- o **Cards** English and Spanish, magnets, bookmarks, etc. Great fundraiser.
- Poster Contest- For all grade levels K-8. Posters are all Christmas themed and awards from Council, State and Supreme levels. Great way to get kids excited about putting Jesus back in Christmas.

* Family Prayer Night (Chairman: Mark Haro)

- Strengthen the bonds within our parishes and build faith-filled families. This is an
 opportunity for council members, their families, and the whole parish
 community to come together once a month for an evening of prayer, dinner, and

 Use the Family Fully Alive Booklets (#10162E or S) support this program. The program provides monthly themes, scripture verses and activities. Through

prayer and reflection, each family has the opportunity to grow in holiness together. This is a flexible program that can be started at any time of the year and continues year-round.

* Consecration of the Holy Family (Chairman: Vacant)

- O To help families live out the joy of Christ, Supreme Chaplain Archbishop William Lori has composed a prayer through which families will come together to consecrate themselves under the protection of the Holy Family. In this prayer, we ask for the aid or intercession of the perfect son Jesus Christ, Mary the perfect mother, and Joseph who is a model for every father.
