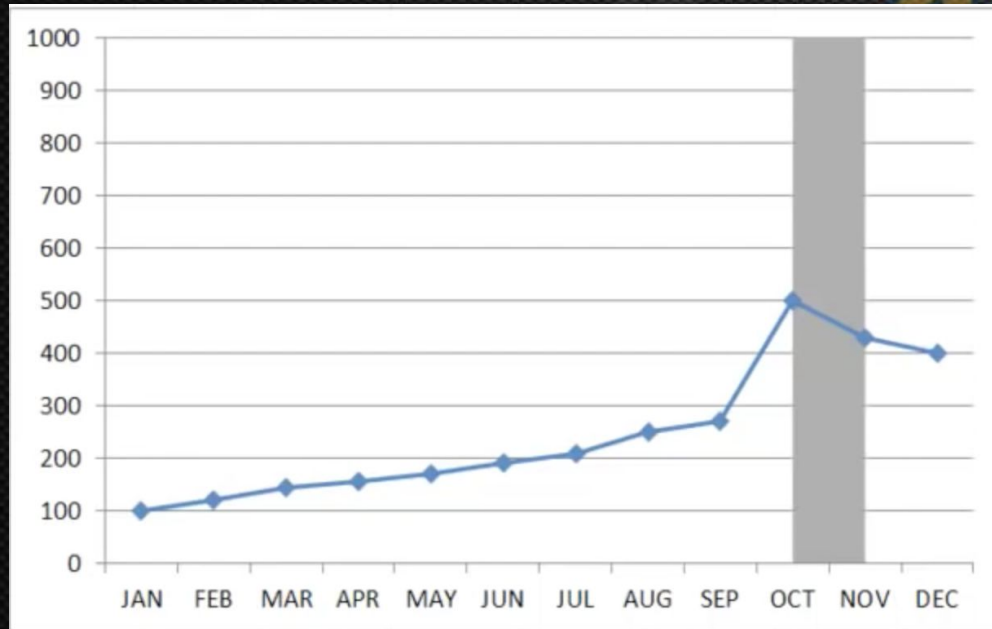

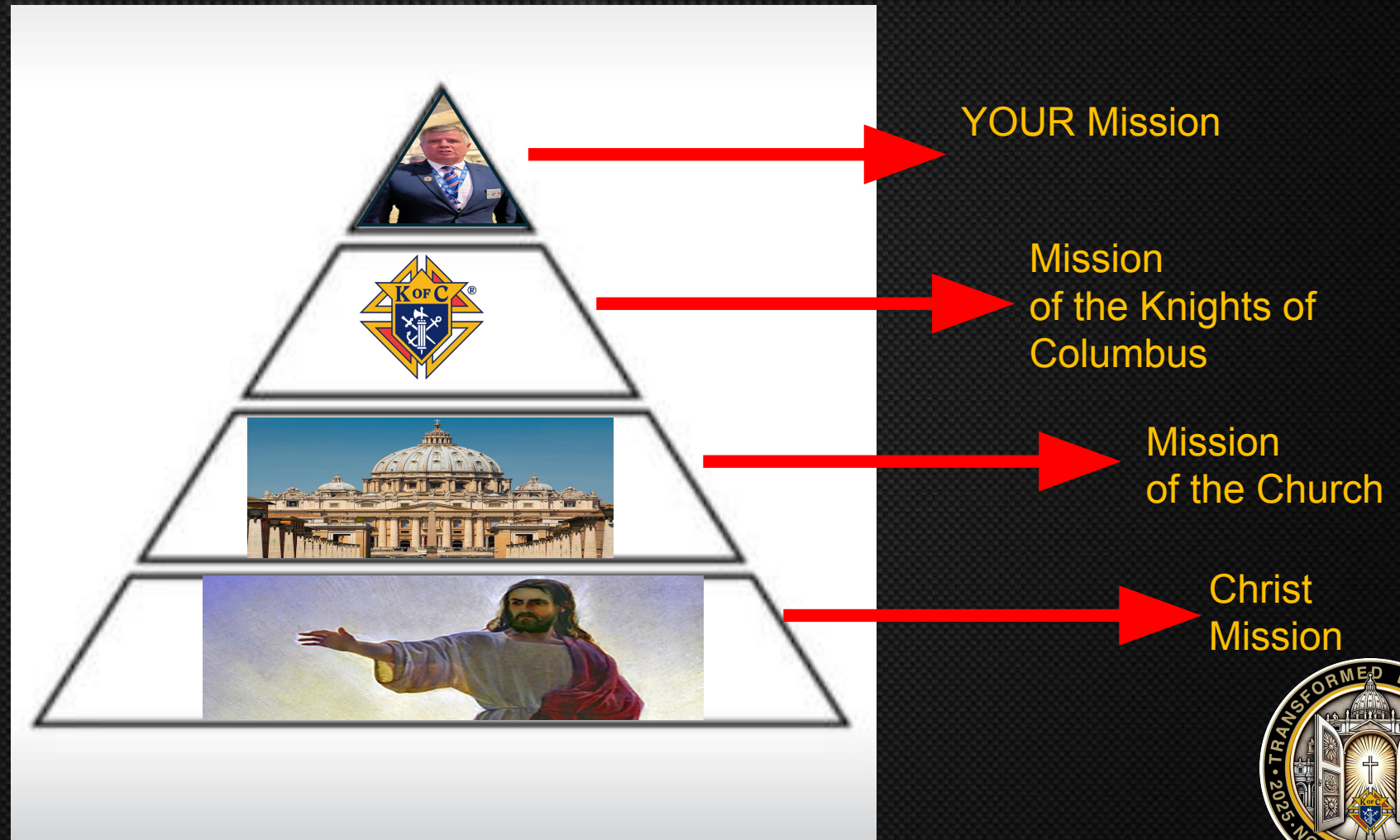

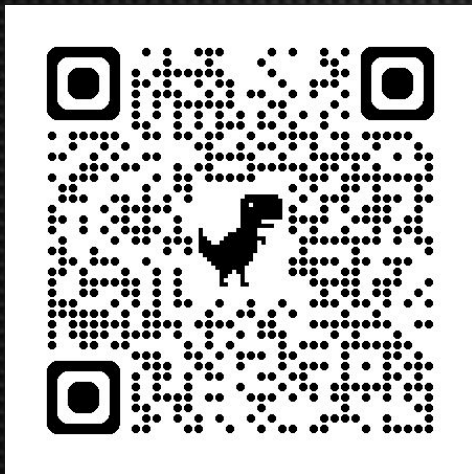

Easy Steps to Follow with Gray Cards

1. Promote in Advance

Make a pulpit announcement in the weeks leading up to the drive. Also include the announcement in the parish bulletin (print and/or electronic).

2. Welcome at the Doors

On the day of the drive, greet all men entering the church with a *Gray Card*, a pen, and a flyer.

3. Pastoral Support

Ask your pastor for permission to make a pulpit announcement during Mass. Read the standard membership message.

4. Collect and Connect

After Mass, collect completed Gray Cards at all exits. Knights should be stationed at every door, ready to share their personal story.

✓ Make sure each card includes a **valid email address**.

5. Candidate Information Entry

Meet as a team to input all card information into joinus.com.

6. Follow-Up Campaign

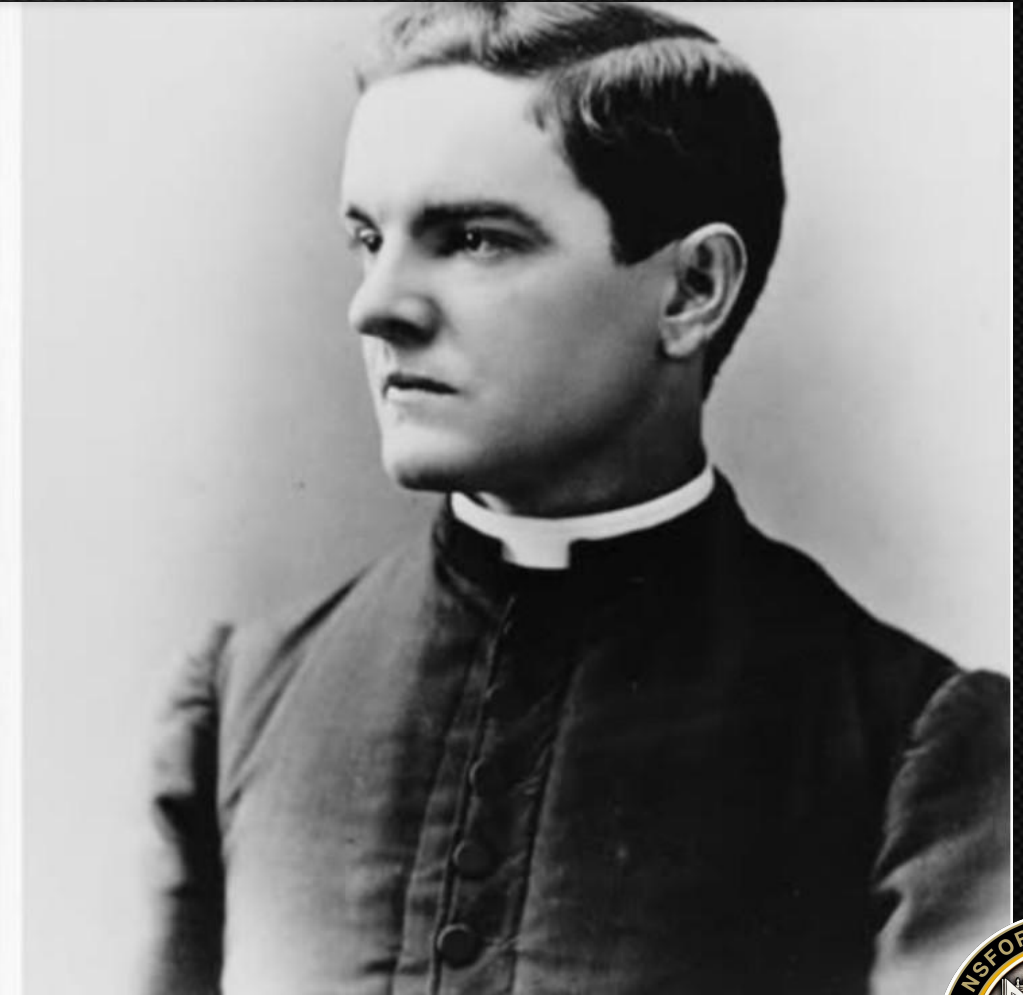
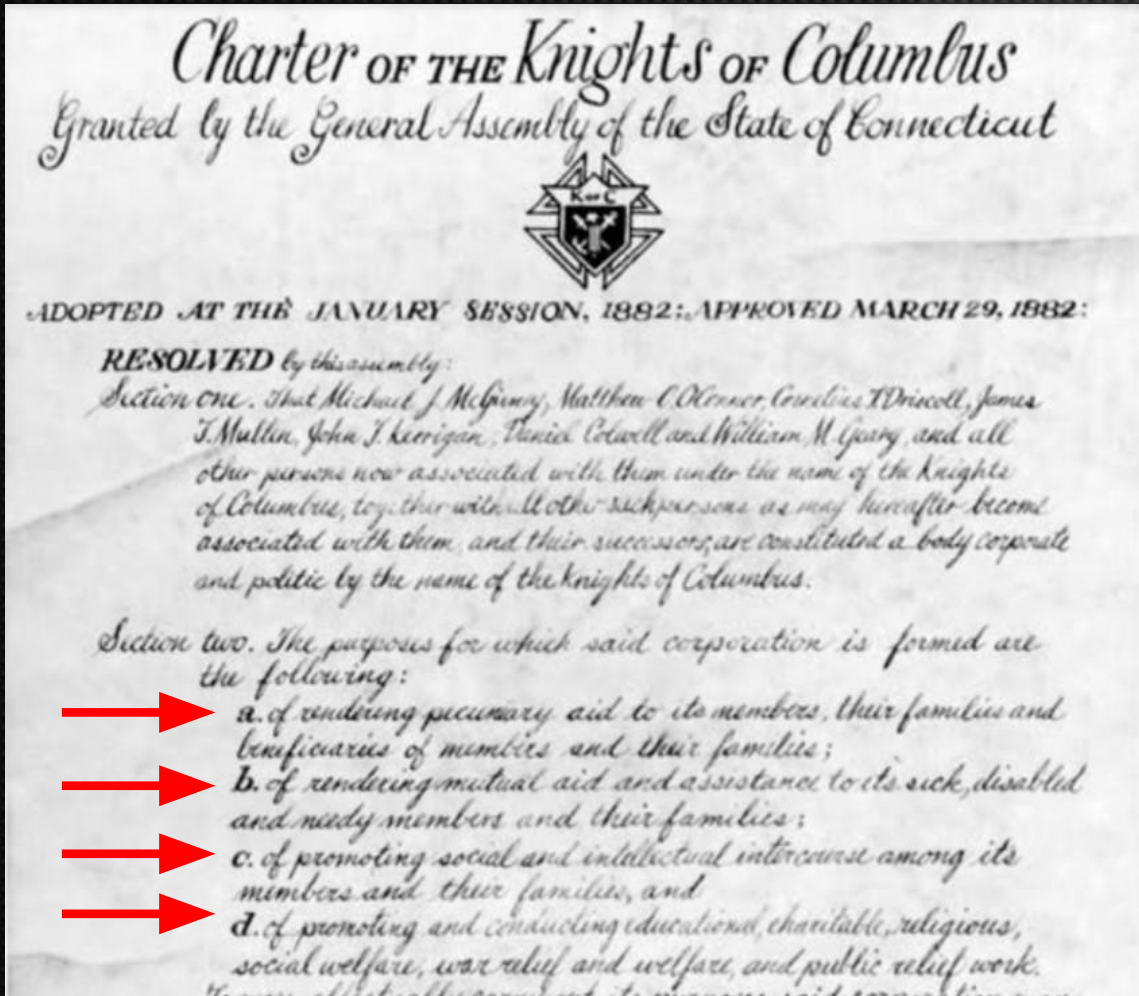
